Gracy Zapata

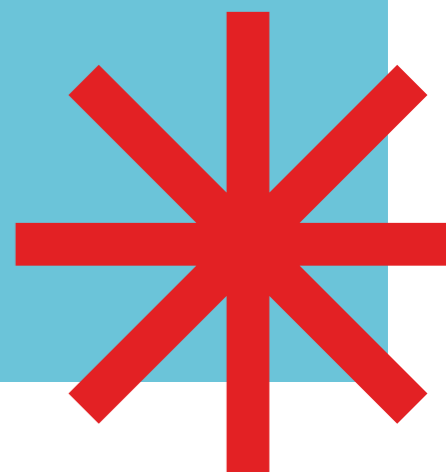
